- 3. Each lot will be sold to the highest bidder. Should identical bids be received on any lot, the first bid received by EAC shall be given preference. Should any dispute arise between bidders on a particular lot, EAC shall decide the same.
- 4. Bidding shall be by mail or in person. Mail bids should be made for the maximum amount you are willing to pay for the applicable lot. Your bid will be reduced as appropriate so that it is only the proper advance over the next highest bid. Mail bids should be made only on the Bid Sheet contained in this catalogue, and should be sent to the address(es) designated thereon. EAC cannot and does not assume any responsibility for or to correct any errors whatever on Bid Sheets. PLEASE RECHECK YOUR BID SHEET CAREFULLY BEFORE MAILING. Mail bidders unknown to the officers of EAC must include a deposit equal to 25% of their total bids. In the discretion of EAC, bids received without such a deposit may not be accepted. EAC will execute mail bids on behalf of its members, without charge or commission; however see Item 6 below.
- 5. Each lot shall be opened for bidding at the reserved amount set forth in this catalogue, or as determined by EAC. No bid of less than \$20 on any U.S. coin lot will be accepted. Bidding shall increase in whole or round dollar amounts, at the discretion of EAC. Bids made in other than whole or round dollar amounts will be reduced to nearest such amount.
- 6. Lots delivered in any state or locality where this sale is conducted may be subject to state and/or local sales tax. Any such sales tax may be invoiced separately after delivery or purchases. Postage or shipping, plus insurance, will be added to the invoice of purchasers who have their purchases shipped.
- This sale is strictly for cash; payment in full for all purchases must be made in current U.S. funds, upon receipt of invoice or prior to delivery of purchases. Title remains with EAC or its consignors until purchases are paid in full.
- 8. Lots designated "as is" are sold on a strictly "AS IS" basis. No returns whatever. All multiple coin lots are sold on a strictly "AS IS" basis.
